Save the date for the 2nd Annual Northern Nevada Women's Leadership Breakfast in Reno on October 19, 2018. The breakfast and program will be held at the Mack Auditorium in Renown Regional Medical Center. The program will also be streamed live to a meeting location at Banner Churchill Community Hospital in Fallon. This year's theme is "Professional Advancement in a Multi-Generational Work Environment." The breakfast is a joint program of NVMGMA and the Nevada chapters of HFMA, ACHE, which are founding members of the Nevada Healthcare Forum.
